

Agel Breaks Ground on New Headquarters

Agel joined a Utah-based development company in breaking ground for its new corporate headquarters at the Thanksgiving Park Business Complex in Lehi, Utah yesterday during an hour-long ceremony to mark the momentous occasion.

The new 135,240 square foot structure is the first of five Class-A office buildings being constructed by Thanksgiving Development in the business park, and will provide needed space for Agel corporate headquarters. Agel is currently operating in a 15,000 square foot Provo facility.

Over 100 people attended the groundbreaking ceremony, including Agel CEO and Founder Glen Jensen, President Craig Bradley, as well as the rest of the executive and management team. Also in attendance were members of the community, including the Lehi City mayor, members of the Lehi City Council, and members of the Thanksgiving Park Development team.

“This represents an historic event for the company,” said Glen. “Two years ago with this idea of gel-base nutritional products, who would have thought in such a short time we would be the anchor tenant in a project of this size.”

Agel will lease the fifth floor with the option of leasing the fourth floor. With both floors, Agel will occupy 60,000 square feet of office space in the five-story building.

The new headquarters is located off the I-15 freeway at 3000 West Ashton Blvd. in Lehi. When the project is fully developed, there will be 730,000 square feet of office space available.
